Romans 4:18-21

Amplified Bible (AMP)

18 [For Abraham, human reason for] hope being gone, hoped in faith that he should become the father of many nations, as he had been promised, So [numberless] shall your descendants be.

19 He did not weaken in faith when he considered the [utter] impotence of his own body, which was as good as dead because he was about a hundred years old, or [when he considered] the barrenness of Sarah's [deadened] womb.

20 No unbelief *or* distrust made him waver (doubtingly question) concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong *and* was empowered by faith as he gave praise *and* glory to God,

21 Fully satisfied *and* assured that God was able *and* mighty to keep His word *and* to do what He had promised.

Abraham Heartily Agreed With God

Verse 18: "Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be."

According to (GK) = Hearty agreement, total, complete, unquestioning, unreserved agreement.

Verse 20: "He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief...."

Verse 21: He was so fully persuaded that, what God had promised in His word, He was totally able to perform.

Abraham was in hearty agreement with what God had spoken to him about being the Father of many nations.

Verse 18 (MSG): "When everything was hopeless, Abraham believed anyway, deciding to live not on the basis of what he saw he couldn't do but on what God said he would do...."

"I am in hearty agreement with what God has already said in His Word about my prosperity."

Deuteronomy 8:18

Amplified Bible (AMP)

18 But you shall [earnestly] remember the Lord your God, for it is He Who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

It is the Lord my God who gives me the power to get wealth in order to establish His covenant in the earth.

Deuteronomy 28

Amplified Bible (AMP)

28 If you will listen diligently to the voice of the Lord your God, being watchful to do all His commandments which I command you this day, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth.

2 And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you if you heed the voice of the Lord your God.

3 Blessed shall you be in the city and blessed shall you be in the field.

4 Blessed shall be the fruit of your body and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your beasts, the increase of your cattle and the young of your flock.

5 Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading trough.

6 Blessed shall you be when you come in and blessed shall you be when you go out.

7 The Lord shall cause your enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways.

8 The Lord shall command the blessing upon you in your storehouse and in all that you undertake. And He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God gives you.

9 The Lord will establish you as a people holy to Himself, as He has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the Lord your God and walk in His ways.

10 And all people of the earth shall see that you are called by the name [and in the presence of] the Lord, and they shall be afraid of you.

11 And the Lord shall make you have a surplus of prosperity, through the fruit of your body, of your

livestock, and of your ground, in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you.

12 The Lord shall open to you His good treasury, the heavens, to give the rain of your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hands; and you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow.

13 And the Lord shall make you the head, and not the tail; and you shall be above only, and you shall not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you this day and are watchful to do them.

14 And you shall not turn aside from any of the words which I command you this day, to the right hand or to the left, to go after other gods to serve them.

a. Verse 2: All these blessings come on me and overtake me.

b. Verse 8: The commanded blessing is upon my storehouses.

c. Verse 11 (AMP): The Lord makes me to have a surplus of prosperity.

d. Verse 12 (AMP): The Lord has opened to me His rich treasury.

Psalm 35:27

Amplified Bible (AMP)

27 Let those who favor my righteous cause *and* have pleasure in my uprightness shout for joy and be glad and say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, Who takes pleasure in the prosperity of His servant. Psalm 35:27: The Lord takes pleasure in my prosperity.

Psalm 36:8

Amplified Bible (AMP)

8 They relish *and* feast on the abundance of Your house; and You cause them to drink of the stream of Your pleasures.

I am abundantly satisfied with the prosperity of God's house and I drink out of the river of His pleasures.

Psalm 65:11

Amplified Bible (AMP)

11 You crown the year with Your bounty *and* goodness, and the tracks of Your [chariot wheels] drip with fatness.

(NLT): You crown my year with a bountiful harvest and even the hard pathways overflow with abundance.

Psalm 66:12

Amplified Bible (AMP)

12 You caused men to ride over our heads [when we were prostrate]; we went through fire and through water, but You brought us out into a broad, moist place [to abundance and refreshment and the open air].

God has brought me out into a wealthy place—a broad and open place of His abundance and refreshment.

Psalm 68:19

Amplified Bible (AMP)

19 Blessed be the Lord, Who bears our burdens *and* carries us day by day, even the God Who is our salvation! *Selah* [pause, and calmly think of that]!

God daily loads me with benefits.

Psalm 85:12

Amplified Bible (AMP)

12 Yes, the Lord will give what is good, and our land will yield its increase.

The Lord shall give me that which is good and our land shall yield her increase.

NLT: The Lord pours down His blessings. Our land will yield its bountiful harvest.

Psalm 92:12

Amplified Bible (AMP)

12 The [uncompromisingly] righteous shall flourish like the palm tree [be long-lived, stately, upright, useful, and fruitful]; they shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon [majestic, stable, durable, and incorruptible].

The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree.

Flourish (Heb.) = Increase; enlarge; become extremely successful; enter into a state of prosperity; grow exuberantly; increase in wealth, favor and honor.

I am increasing, enlarging, becoming extremely successful and have entered into a state of prosperity.

I am growing exuberantly and increasing in wealth, favor and honor.

Psalm 112:3

Amplified Bible (AMP)

3 Prosperity *and* welfare are in his house, and his righteousness endures forever.

Wealth and riches are in my house.

Jerusalem Bible: There are riches and wealth for my family.

AMP: Prosperity and welfare are in my house.

Psalm 115:14

Amplified Bible (AMP)

14 May the Lord give you increase more and more, you and your children.

The Lord is increasing me more and more—me and my children.

Proverbs 8:21

Amplified Bible (AMP)

21 That I may cause those who love me to inherit [true] riches and that I may fill their treasuries.

Because I love the Lord, He causes me to inherit true riches and He fills my treasures.

Proverbs 13:22

Amplified Bible (AMP)

22 A good man leaves an inheritance [of moral stability and goodness] to his children's children, and the wealth of the sinner [finds its way eventually] into the hands of the righteous, for whom it was laid up.

I leave an inheritance to my children's children and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for me.

Proverbs 19:14

Amplified Bible (AMP)

14 House and riches are the inheritance from fathers, but a wise, understanding, *and* prudent wife is from the Lord.

House and riches are my inheritance.

Proverbs 24:3-4

Amplified Bible (AMP)

3 Through skillful *and* godly Wisdom is a house (a life, a home, a family) built, and by understanding it is established [on a sound and good foundation],

4 And by knowledge shall its chambers [of every area] be filled with all precious and pleasant riches.

Ecclesiastes 5:19

Amplified Bible (AMP)

19 Also, every man to whom God has given riches and possessions, and the power to enjoy them and to accept his appointed lot and to rejoice in his toil—this is the gift of God [to him].

(NLT): I receive wealth from God and the health to enjoy it. It is a good thing!

Isaiah 48:17

Amplified Bible (AMP)

17 Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: I am the Lord your God, Who teaches you to profit, Who leads you in the way that you should go.

It is the Lord my God which teaches me to profit and leads me in the way that I should go.

Malachi 3:10

Amplified Bible (AMP)

10 Bring all the tithes (the whole tenth of your income) into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and prove Me now by it, says the Lord of hosts, if I will not open the windows of heaven for you and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

The windows of heaven are open over me and God is pouring out a blessing that I cannot contain.

2 Corinthians 8:9

Amplified Bible (AMP)

9 For you are becoming progressively acquainted with *and* recognizing more strongly *and* clearly the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ (His kindness, His gracious generosity, His undeserved favor and spiritual blessing), [in] that though He was [so very] rich, yet for your sakes He became [so very] poor, in order that by His poverty you might become enriched (abundantly supplied).

(NLT): Jesus became poor in order that by His poverty I am enriched and abundantly supplied.

- a. By Jesus' stripes, I am healed.
- b. By Jesus' poverty, I am rich.

2 Peter 1:3

Amplified Bible (AMP)

3 For His divine power has bestowed upon us all things that [are requisite and suited] to life and godliness, through the [full, personal] knowledge of Him Who called us by *and* to His own glory and excellence (virtue).
