Amplified Bible (AMP)

9 And let us not lose heart *and* grow weary *and* faint in acting nobly *and* doing right, for in due time *and* at the appointed season we shall reap, if we do not loosen *and* relax our courage *and* faint.

Many Ask the question: “Why isn’t it working for me?”

When they tithe and sow and don’t see results, they get discouraged, and wonder why it doesn’t work.

Amplified Bible (AMP)

Amplified Bible (AMP)

35 Do not, therefore, fling away your fearless confidence, for it carries a great *and* glorious compensation of reward.

36 For you have need of steadfast patience *and* endurance, so that you may perform *and* fully accomplish the will of God, and thus receive *and* [a]carry away [and enjoy to the full] what is promised.

practice of patient endurance *and* waiting are [now] inheriting the promises.

Patience. Not knuckling under and hunkering down until the storm passes over.

Maintaining your stand in spite of the circumstances.

Being constant all the time.

The ability to see the results before you have them.

Amplified Bible (AMP)
