Day 17: Nothing is Impossible with God

God desires to move powerfully in your life. His plans for you are always progressing and developing. He desires to communicate with you like He did with Abraham when He spoke to him as a friend. When your desire for God is greater than your desire for food or drink His Word becomes your strength. The Bread of His Presence will fill you instead of the refuse of religion. Then "you will decree a thing and it will be established for you" (Job22:28)

On Your Seventeenth Day of Fasting, remember:

- Stay in God's Word
- Stay Hydrated at all times
- Continually Pray
- Listen to your favorite worship CDs
- Maintain your journal
- Meditate and listen to what God is saying

Physical and Spiritual Effects:

- Weight loss continues
- Bad breath continues
- Cravings are apparent

Thoughts for your Journal:

Reflect on those situations from God's Word that seemed impossible but for the power of God. What situations in your life seem impossible – and need God's touch?

Attention:

Read this > Luke 4:1-13

This will probably be the toughest week of this 21 day fast. You are getting closer to the end of this fast. Satan will try and tempt you every way he can. He doesn't want you to accomplish this fast. Read the word extra hard, Pray even more and Worship even Longer.

Prayer Focus Day 17: Mentors and Discipleship

"As they were going along the road, someone said to Him 'I will follow You wherever You go' (Luke 9:57 NASV). It is one thing to say you will follow Jesus, it is another to see it through, even when the road is narrow, steep, and nearly impossible. Ecclesiastes 12:13 Amplified Bible (AMP)

13 All has been heard; the end of the matter is: Fear God [revere and worship Him, knowing that He is] and keep His commandments, for this is the whole of man [the full, original purpose of his creation, the object of God's providence, the root of character, the foundation of all happiness, the adjustment to all inharmonious circumstances and conditions under the sun] *and* the whole [duty] for every man.

Father, my whole duty is to fear you with a loving awe and respect. I worship you because you are the great I AM. I know that you are bringing all inharmonious circumstances into order for me because I obey your great commands.

Proverbs 22:4 Amplified Bible (AMP)

4 The reward of humility *and* the reverent *and* worshipful fear of the Lord is riches and honor and life.

Father, thank you for the rewards you give to me. They are riches and honor and life.

Revelation 14:7 Amplified Bible (AMP)

7 And he cried with a mighty voice, Revere God and give Him glory (honor and praise in worship), for the hour of His judgment has arrived. Fall down before Him; pay Him homage *and* adoration *and* worship Him Who created heaven and earth, the sea and the springs (fountains) of water.

MY GREAT GOD! I revere you and give you glory, honor and praise in worship. I fall down before You in my secret place and pay homage and adoration to you and You alone. I love You Lord and I obey your Word and am a doer of it.
