Father speak to us, change us, we look to you as the great master. As we contend for the supernatural

Matthew 6:6

Amplified Bible (AMP)

6 But when you pray, go into your [most] private room, and, closing the door, pray to your Father, Who is in secret; and your Father, Who sees in secret, will reward you *in the open*.

The secret place is where you meet with God every day of your life.

You become:

- a) Changed.

You receive:

1) Enter Daily!

Psalm 88:9

Amplified Bible (AMP)

9 My eye grows dim because of sorrow *and* affliction. Lord, I have called daily on You; I have spread forth my hands to You.

2) Enter with expectation.

Hebrews 11:6

Amplified Bible (AMP)

6 But without faith it is impossible to please *and* be satisfactory to Him. For whoever would come near to God must [necessarily] believe that God exists and that He is the rewarder of those who earnestly *and* diligently seek Him [out].

Expectation is a current that sweeps you into the presence of God.

- a) Expect God to speak to you.
- b) Expect pain to leave your body.
- c) Expect confusion to leave your mind.

- d) Expect revelation to come to you.
- e) Expect personal change to come.
- f) Expect supernatural joy.

3) Enter before making a financial decision

Philippians 4:19

Amplified Bible (AMP)

19 And my God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

4) Enter confessing your weakness and expect to be made strong.

Philippians 4:13

Amplified Bible (AMP)

13 I have strength for all things in Christ Who empowers me [I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me; I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency].

5) Enter with a broken and contrite spirit.

Psalms 34:18

Amplified Bible (AMP)

18 The Lord is close to those who are of a broken heart and saves such as are crushed with sorrow for sin *and* are humbly *and* thoroughly penitent.

- 6) Enter when you feel forsaken and all alone.

Psalm 37:25

Amplified Bible (AMP)

25 I have been young and now am old, yet have I not seen the [uncompromisingly] righteous forsaken or their seed begging bread.

7) Enter when you need Mercy.

Psalm 57:10

Amplified Bible (AMP)

10 For Your mercy *and* loving-kindness are great, reaching to the heavens, and Your truth *and* faithfulness to the clouds.

8) Enter when you have fallen into sin and erred.

Psalm 37:23-24

Amplified Bible (AMP)

23 The steps of a [good] man are directed *and* established by the Lord when He delights in his way [and He busies Himself with his every step].

24 Though he falls, he shall not be utterly cast down, for the Lord grasps his hand in support *and* upholds him.

9) Enter when slanderous words are stirring up enemies of strife against you.

Psalm 31:20

Amplified Bible (AMP)

20 In the secret place of Your presence You hide them from the plots of men; You keep them secretly in Your pavilion from the strife of tongues.

10) Enter during seasons of confusion and change.

Psalm 31:15

Amplified Bible (AMP)

15 My times are in Your hands; deliver me from the hands of my foes and those who pursue me *and* persecute me.

11) Enter when you are divided in your decision making and don't know which road to take.

Psalm 32:8

Amplified Bible (AMP)

8 I [the Lord] will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.

12) Enter when bankruptcy threatens and poverty is strangling you financially.

Psalm 34:6

Amplified Bible (AMP)

6 This poor man cried, and the Lord heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles.

13) Enter when you are threatened, abused or afraid.

Psalm 34:7

Amplified Bible (AMP)

7 The Angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him [who revere and worship Him with awe] and each of them He delivers.

14) Enter when you feel that your dreams and goals are unachievable.

Psalm 34:9-10

Amplified Bible (AMP)

9 O fear the Lord, you His saints [revere and worship Him]! For there is no want to those who truly revere *and* worship Him *with* godly fear.

10 The young lions lack food and suffer hunger, but they who seek (inquire of and require) the Lord [by right of their need and on the authority of His Word], none of them shall lack any beneficial thing.

15) Enter when everything is going well and perfect in your life.

Psalm 32:2

Amplified Bible (AMP)

2 Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) is the man to whom the Lord imputes no iniquity and in whose spirit there is no deceit.
