Hair in a bun or ragged.

False concepts

- 1)** Outward appearance produces Holiness. FALSE
- 2)** Superior Holier than thou attitude. FALSE
- 3)** Rules, Do's and don'ts and monastic vows. False

Holiness is used 620 times in the Bible.

Ephesians 4:17-24

Amplified Bible (AMP)

17 So this I say and solemnly testify in [the name of] the Lord [as in His presence], that you must no longer live as the heathen (the Gentiles) do in their perverseness [in the folly, vanity, and emptiness of their souls and the futility] of their minds.

18 Their moral understanding is darkened and their reasoning is beclouded. [They are] alienated (estranged, self-banished) from the life of God [with no share in it; this is] because of the ignorance (the want of knowledge and perception, the willful blindness) that is **[b]**deep-seated in them, due to their hardness of heart [to the insensitiveness of their moral nature].

19 In their spiritual apathy they have become callous and past feeling and reckless and have abandoned themselves [a prey] to unbridled sensuality, eager and greedy to indulge in every form of impurity [that their depraved desires may suggest and demand].

20 But you did not so learn Christ!

21 Assuming that you have really heard Him and been taught by Him, as [all] Truth is in Jesus [embodied and personified in Him],

22 Strip yourselves of your former nature [put off and discard your old unrenewed self] which characterized your previous manner of life and becomes corrupt through lusts and desires that spring from delusion;

23 And be constantly renewed in the spirit of your mind [having a fresh mental and spiritual attitude],

24 And put on the new nature (the regenerate self) created in God's image, [Godlike] in true righteousness and holiness.

1 Thessalonians 4:7

Amplified Bible (AMP)

7 For God has not called us to impurity but to consecration [to dedicate ourselves to the most thorough purity].

1 Peter 1:14-16

Amplified Bible (AMP)

14 [Live] as children of obedience [to God]; do not conform yourselves to the evil desires [that governed you] in your former ignorance [when you did not know the requirements of the Gospel].

15 But as the One Who called you is holy, you yourselves also be holy in all your conduct and manner of living.

16 For it is written, You shall be holy, for I am holy.

Holiness will make you a more Beautiful person.

Psalms 29:2

Amplified Bible (AMP)

2 Give to the Lord the glory due to His name; worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness or in holy array.

Psalms 96:9

Amplified Bible (AMP)

9 O worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness; tremble before and reverently fear Him, all the earth.

Psalm 110:3

Amplified Bible (AMP)

3 Your people will offer themselves willingly in the day of Your power, in the beauty of holiness and in holy array out of the womb of the morning; to You [will spring forth] Your young men, who are as the dew.

Holiness will help you to walk in the supernatural.

Isaiah 35:3-8

Amplified Bible (AMP)

3 Strengthen the weak hands and make firm the feeble and tottering knees.

4 Say to those who are of a fearful and hasty heart, Be strong, fear not! Behold, your God will come with vengeance; with the recompense of God He will come and save you.

5 Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.

6 Then shall the lame man leap like a hart, and the tongue of the dumb shall sing for joy. For waters shall break forth in the wilderness and streams in the desert.

7 And the burning sand and the mirage shall become a pool, and the thirsty ground springs of water; in the haunt of jackals, where they lay resting, shall be grass with reeds and rushes.

8 And a highway shall be there, and a way; and it shall be called the Holy Way. The unclean shall not pass over it, but it shall be for the redeemed; the wayfaring men,

yes, the simple ones and fools, shall not err in it and lose their way.

2 Timothy 2:21

Amplified Bible (AMP)

21 So whoever cleanses himself [from what is ignoble and unclean, who separates himself from contact with contaminating and corrupting influences] will [then himself] be a vessel set apart and useful for honorable and noble purposes, consecrated and profitable to the Master, fit and ready for any good work.

Crucifixion

Step 1

Remember the old nature

Step 2

Must consider ourselves dead to sin but alive to Christ

Romans 6:11

Amplified Bible (AMP)

11 Even so consider yourselves also dead to sin and your relation to it broken, but alive to God [living in unbroken fellowship with Him] in Christ Jesus.

Step 3

Resist temptation to yield your members to sin

Romans 6:12-13

Amplified Bible (AMP)

12 Let not sin therefore rule as king in your mortal (short-lived, perishable) bodies, to make you yield to its cravings and be subject to its lusts and evil passions.

13 Do not continue offering or yielding your bodily members [and faculties] to sin as instruments (tools) of wickedness. But offer and yield yourselves to God as though you have been raised from the dead to [perpetual] life, and your bodily members [and faculties] to God, presenting them as implements of righteousness.

Step 4

Yield yourself as an instrument to righteousness

Romans 6:13

Amplified Bible (AMP)

13 Do not continue offering or yielding your bodily members [and faculties] to sin as instruments (tools) of wickedness. But offer and yield yourselves to God as though you have been raised from the dead to [perpetual] life, and your bodily members [and [faculties]] to God, presenting them as implements of righteousness.

Obedience

2 Thessalonians 3:14

Amplified Bible (AMP)

14 But if anyone [in the church] refuses to obey what we say in this letter, take note of that person and do not associate with him, so that he may be ashamed.

Hebrews 5:9

Amplified Bible (AMP)

9 And, [His completed experience] making Him perfectly [equipped], He became the Author and Source of eternal salvation to all those who give heed and obey Him,
